

NTUC Transition Advisory Council Information

The Transition Advisory Council is being formed by invitation of the Board of Trustees. Membership on the Council will be 2 Board members – Leslie Sharp and Star Staubach – and 4 active congregants.

Purpose: To advise the Board and give support to the transitional ministry specialist(s) to facilitate agreed-upon transition activities for our spiritual community, which may include activities such as:

- Coming to terms and peace with history
- Discovering a new identity and commitment to new directions
- Resolving conflicts and becoming a healthy congregation
- Renewing connection to spiritual principles

Selection Criteria:

- An active congregant (NTUC membership not required)
- Committed to spiritual growth and participating in workshops and classes
- Willing to listen to and hear all congregants
- Open to all points of view

Process and Timeline:

- Sept 13 – Informational meeting. Board will present additional information on the purpose of the Council and expectations of its members, discuss details on the process, and answer attendee questions about topics related to the Council.
- Sept 21 – Congregants interested in serving on the Council will submit an application by this date.
- Sept 26-27 – Board panel will interview applicants. Panel will be the 2 Board representatives on the Council plus 1 additional Board member.
- Sept 28-Oct 1 – Board will select applicants to be invited to serve on the Council and extend invitations
- Oct 2 – Names of congregant members on the Council will be announced.
