The call of God to Abraham, *The LORD said to Abraham, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you."* Genesis 12:1

Say, *"We believe in God, and in what was sent down to us, and in what was sent down to Abraham, Ismael, Jacob, and the Matriarchs, and in what was given to Moses, Jesus, and the prophets from their Lord. We make no distinction among any of them. To Him alone we are submitters."* Qur'an 3:8
Now there is peace on earth and it has begun with me.

Every Sunday morning, every Wednesday night, every time Unity people are together we sing that line. How do find this peace in ourselves? How are we living in peace with every human being on our planet? We will be finding answers to this question this year during the Season for Non-Violence 2006.

Today, as I began writing this article I heard that there were two pipe bombs set off at the Mosque in Clifton. Rev. Pat and I went there to offer prayers and support and met with some of the leaders of the mosque. We are hoping to join with them and Rabbi Abie Ingber, Executive Director of the Hillel Jewish Student Center of the University of Cincinnati in a Peace Walk at the end of the series which will be a practical and visible symbolic gesture for outer peace.

For the Season for Non-Violence 2006, The Association of Global New Thought, of which New Thought Unity was a founding member ten years ago, is focusing on Abraham who is considered the common ancestor of the over 3 billion people who are Jews, Muslims, and Christians. We

will study the Abraham Path for Peace with others from all these religious traditions around the world and search for our common ground in this quest for inner and outer peace.

It is widely known that religion is deeply implicated in the conflict in the Middle East. The potential role of spirituality in conflict transformation, however, is less understood. One of the most important findings of conflict resolution research in recent years is that the global peace-building community is now identifying important ways in which spiritually motivated action can and is contributing to the healing of deep wounds that have perpetuated this particular tragic conflict.

New Thought Unity is partnering with The Association for Global New Thought, the Interreligious Engagement Project for the 21st Century (IEP21), and the Global Negotiation Project at Harvard University and is working to create an 'Abraham Path for Peace Walk' in Cincinnati for the finale of our series. Details of the walk are still to be determined but, if you would like to be part of the organizing effort, contact either Rev. Doris or Rev. Pat.

AMAN MOTWANE, AUTHOR AND LECTURER, VISITS JANUARY 23 & 24

Aman Motwane, author of *The Power of Wisdom*, will be presenting workshops at New Thought Unity Center on Monday and Tuesday, January 23 and 24. The all-encompassing workshop title for both nights is *When You Change How You See the World, Your Whole World Changes*. On Monday night, the focus is on the subject of "relationships," while on Tuesday Aman shifts his focus to "prosperity."



